  - We want to change that



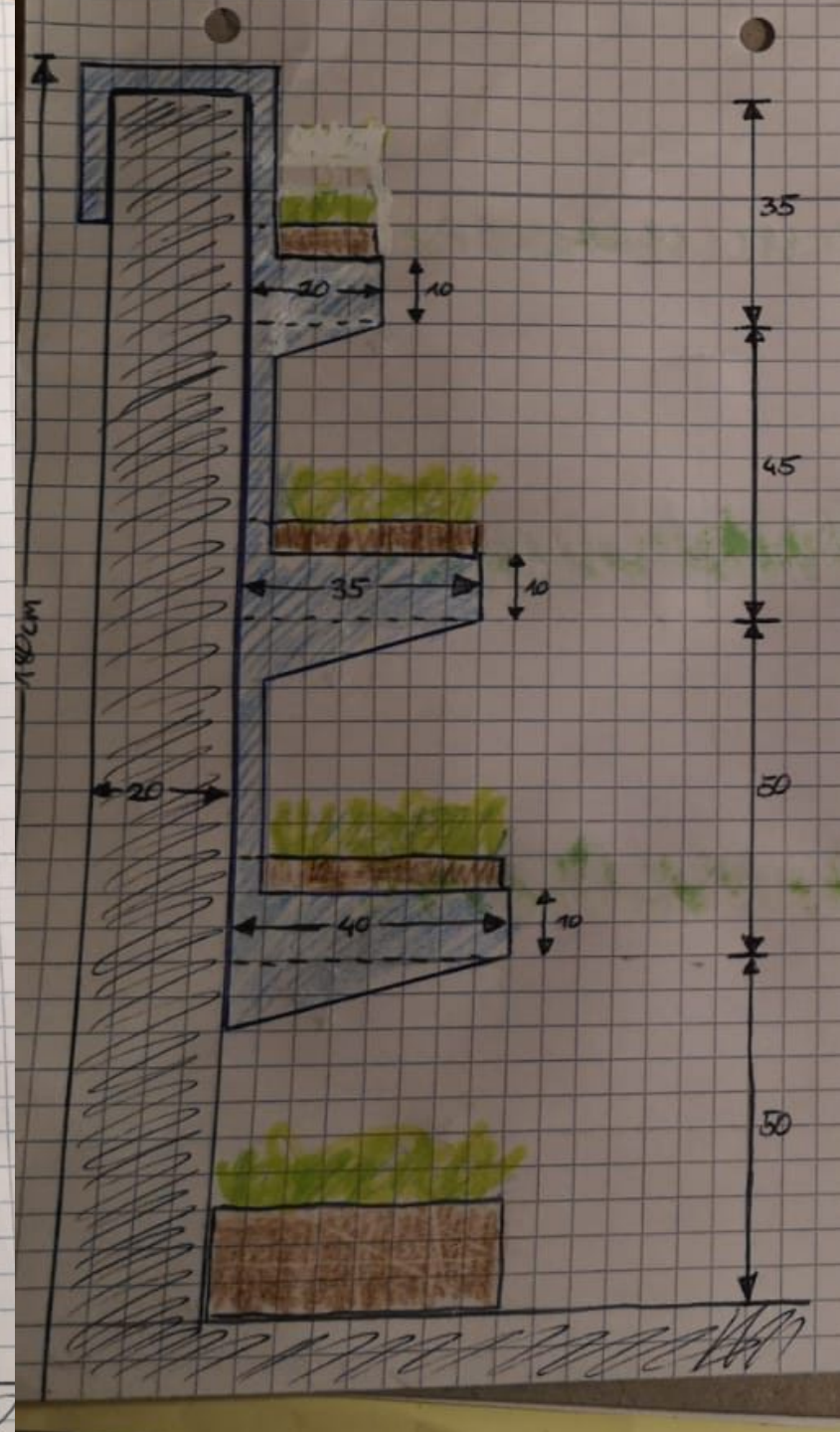
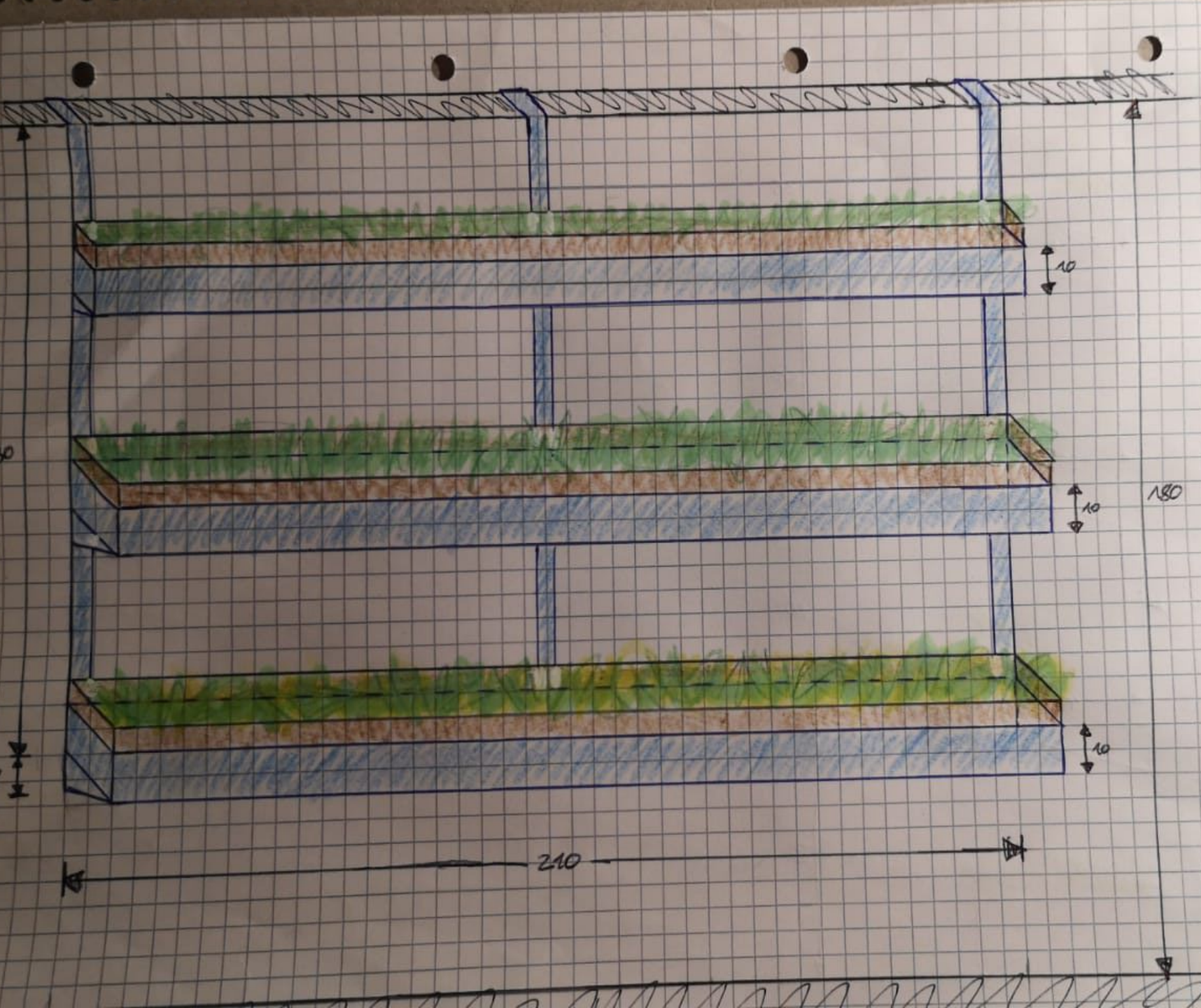
# The Idea
