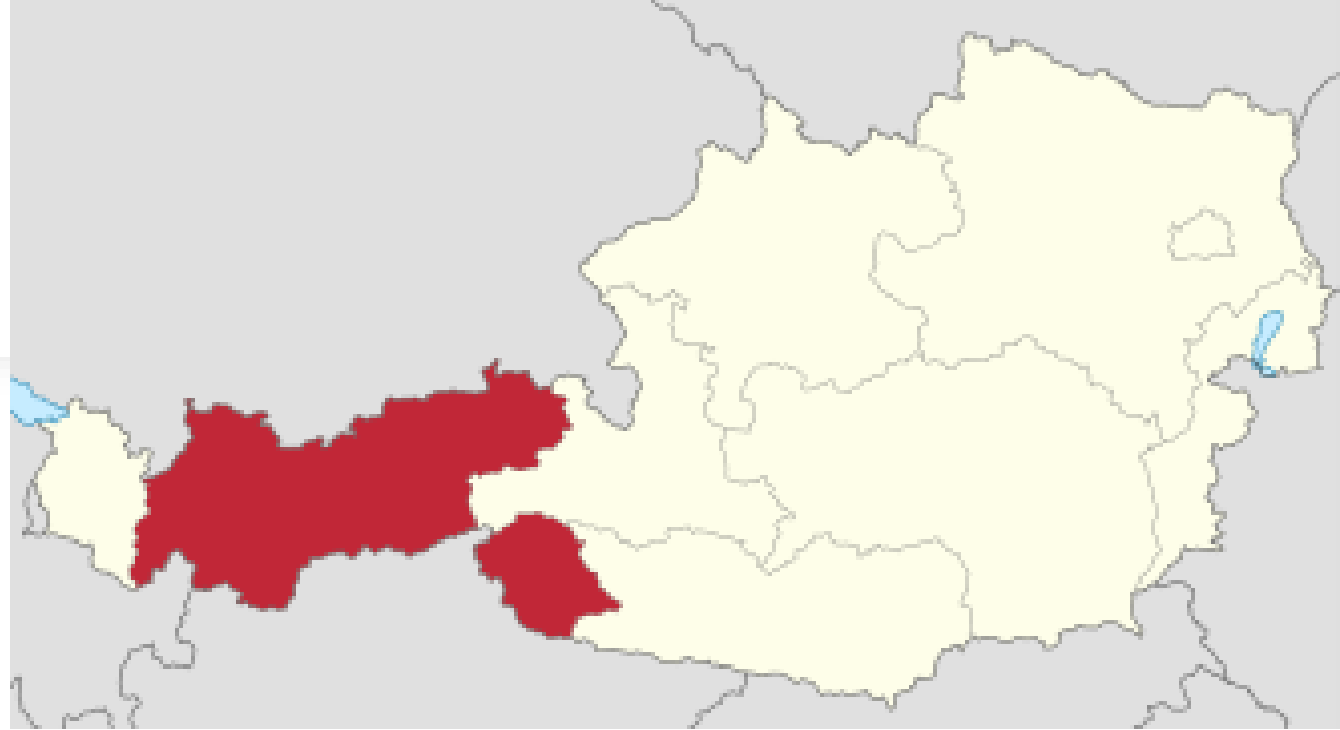
Core Concepts – Water Diplomacy

Conflicts in Tyrol

- importance of glaciers for tourism
 - ~3,6 billion euros per season
- receding of glaciers
 - lose 15-20cm of length per year
- decreasing snowfall
 - 92% less snowfall

Conflicts in Tyrol

- water consumption for artificial snow
 - 1,5 Olympic swimming pools
- economic and environmental conflict
